

Who we are

We are people from different fields, who want fair medical care for all. We are independent from any institutions and our financial base consists of donations. We work on a voluntary basis, together with the Migrationszentrum Göttingen and with translators.

What we do

We support refugees in medical questions and if needed we arrange doctors appointments. In addition we help getting medicines and can accompany someone to a doctor. Our help is anonymous. We aim to build up a nationwide network between groups of “medical aid supporters” and doctors. At the same time we try to fight politically for the rights of refugees.

What we want (and why)

Medical care is a basic right of every human being, but for many people it is not guaranteed. Especially for refugees it is not a reality. This is why we want to create possibilities for sufficient medical care for all those who are denied it. But we want more. Because the restriction of basic rights for refugees is part of an increasingly repressive politic of migration. This reflects the political and public racism in our society. Current laws cause discrimination and exclusion of people with other nationalities, especially those from so-called developing countries. For example asylumseekers are not entitled to care for chronic diseases. Refugees are deported even if they are pursued in their home countries.

Human beings are restricted in their freedom of movement only because of their nationality (Residenzpflichtgesetz). Because of this, we stand up for the rights of all people, no matter their nationality or status. We want to expose the human rights abuses and the daily racism that is the experience of migrants and refugees in this country. Our aim is public (health-) care for all so that our support is not needed anymore.

What we need:

- support for medical aid for refugees from other health care workers
- doctors to treat refugees anonymous and for free
- donations to continue our work
- that everybody should support refugees in their daily life
- all politicians to respect human rights, also in legislation, and to treat all human beings equally
- And we are looking for people to join us
